

ANNEX 3A
PRODUCT SPECIFIC RULES OF ORIGIN

Part I - General Interpretative Note

1. For the purpose of interpreting the rules of origin set forth in this Annex:
 - (a) the specific rule, or specific set of rules, that apply to a particular heading or subheading is set out immediately adjacent to the heading or subheading;
 - (b) the requirement of a change in tariff classification applies only to non-originating materials;
 - (c) where a specific rule of origin is defined using the criterion of a change in tariff classification, the rule will be considered to be met only if each of the non-originating materials used in the production of the good have undergone the change in tariff classification;
 - (d) where a specific rule of origin is defined using the criterion of a change in tariff classification, and it is written to exclude tariff provisions at the level of a chapter, heading, or subheading of the Harmonized System (HS), it shall be construed to mean that the rule of origin requires that materials classified in those excluded provisions be originating for the good to qualify as originating; and
 - (e) when a heading or subheading is subject to alternative specific rules of origin, the rule will be considered to be met if a good satisfies one of the alternatives.
2. For the purpose of column 1 of this Annex, when the term “ex” is used before the tariff code it means that the rule specified for that tariff code is an exception from the general rule specified for the Chapter.
3. For the purposes of this Annex:

chapter means the first two digits in the tariff classification number under the HS;

heading means the first four digits in the tariff classification number under the HS;

subheading means the first six digits in the tariff classification number under the HS.
4. For the purposes of column 3 of this Annex:
 - (a) **WO** means the material of the same chapter that is wholly obtained according to the criteria as per Article 4 of Chapter 3 (Rules of Origin).

- (b) **CC** means that all non-originating materials used in the production of the good have undergone a change in tariff classification at the 2-digit level;
- (c) **CTH** means that all non-originating materials used in the production of the good have undergone a change in tariff classification at the 4-digit level;
- (d) **CTSH** means that all non-originating materials used in the production of the good have undergone a change in tariff classification at the 6-digit level;
- (e) **N/A** means no rules are applicable.

5. Using the rule CC, CTH and CTSH, must be done by manufacturing process.
