Identification number that is valid throughout the EU

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What is a certificate of origin?


Certificate of origin

You need to provide a proof of the origin of the product, especially now under EVFTA



This document shall be accompanied by the SAD: this is a common import declaration form for all EU countries

Customs

Common Custom Tariffs and Free Movement of Goods

Payement of VAT at the moment of entry into the EU

Excise duty for certain goods to be paid when released for consumption

Custom clearance: the Single Administrative Document


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Sanitary measures



Provides advice on food safety issues

CE

Product has been assessed and complies with EU requirements.

Mandatory for 25 product groups. If not mandatory, it cannot be used.

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Product safety



For certain substances manufactured or imported in quantities of one tonne or more per year per company.

Substances of very high concern.

Downstreams users must be informed (Safety Data Sheets).



Authorizations granted only to applicants established in the EU.

Companies may submit a single application.

EU Consumers' rights

Core principles

- Only applies if habitual residence of the consumer in the EU + the trader pursues in or directs such activities to that country;
- Precontractual information is essential;
- Exporters must not engage in unfair commercial practices such as misleading or agressive practices.



Intellectual property

Protected designation of origin



Agricultural products of foodstuffs from a specific region whose quality or characteristics are essentially or exclusively due to the geographical environment

Must have been produced, processed and put together in that specific geographical area

Protected geographical indication



May be attributed to agricultural products or foodstuff that are from a specific region and for which a specific quality, reputation, or other characteristic may be attributed to that region.

Must have been produced, processed and put together in that specific geographical area

Traditional specialty guaranteed



Foodstuffs and agricultural products without a link to specific geographical area.

This recognition is based on the specificity of the product, that is, the characteristics that clearly distinguish it from other products or foodstuffs from the same category.



Carbon Border Adjustment Mechanism



EU importers of goods covered by the CBAM registers with national authorities where they can also buy CBAM certificates. Certificates are prices based on weekly ETS allowances



EU importer declares the emissions embedded in its imports and surrenders the corresponding number of certificates each year



If importers can prove that a carbon price has already been paid during the production of the imported goods, the corresponding amount can be deducted.
